### REQUEST FROM TOM HAGGERT

Tom, the Vice-Chair from Kawartha Lakes Pickleball Association has a proposition for our other affiliated clubs or if you know of a municipality that would like to join in the following:

We are considering the use of this new product <a href="PickleRoll">PickleRoll</a> matting (you can see the video on YouTube). We are wondering if any other clubs are considering the same and seeing if we could create a buying group to get better pricing. My initial communication with PickleRoll was they will not consider discounting unless the order is larger than 12 units (we were asking about 6 mats). Each 30' x 60' mat costs \$8,000 USD.

So, that is our ask in a nutshell. Looking to build a buying group, perhaps for other pickleball related items as well.
