• Candidate must maintain an 80% (or equivalent) overall academic average.

Candidate must be a registered member in good

standing of Pickleball Ontario/Pickleball Canada.
Candidate must be able to demonstrate their involvement in pickleball.

• Be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident in Ontario; or have proof of status as a Protected Person or Convention Refugee from Immigration and Citizenship Canada (claimants are not eligible)

Must be entering or already enrolled in full-time Diploma or Post-Graduate Certificate studies in an eligible field of study at an eligible institution*
Candidate must be able to demonstrate their

involvement in the game of Pickleball.

• Program must be a minimum length of two semesters

• Have not previously received the award

*<u>Eligible institutions</u>: Canadian educational institutions which have recognized degree/diploma-granting powers, or their affiliates (e.g., universities and colleges).

*Five scholarships in total. \$2,000 available for each scholarship.
